

Sample Media Outreach Letter

Thank you for taking the time to spread the word about National Therapy Animal Day on April 30. We've drafted the following letter so you can easily connect with your local media contacts to see if they are interested in featuring a "good news" story about Pet Partners.

Use these steps to create your own letter to your local media:

- 1. Do an online search for the top news outlets in your area, including the main networks—ABC, CBS, Fox, and NBC—as well as local newspapers, community news outlets such as blogs, and local radio news.
- 2. Copy and paste the language below into the body of your email to the media outlet.
- 3. Personalize this language as appropriate.
- 4. Follow up with a phone call a day or so later if you do not hear back.

Sample language:
